



## National Fuel would like to correct the misinformation included in a recent letter that was sent to residents of the Timberlake subdivision in Wheatfield N.Y.

- The revised Pendleton Compressor Station location, as filed with FERC, allows **National Fuel to avoid the replacement 3.05 miles of Line XM-10 and any construction near Timberlake Estates.**
- **The proposed Pendleton compressor station would not be the largest station in New York State.** The largest FERC-regulated compressor station in New York is 40,010 horsepower. The proposed station, slated at 22,000 horsepower, would not be an unusually large station.
- **This project will transport natural gas to markets throughout the North American pipeline system.** Canada's natural gas markets are heavily integrated with those of the United States. Canada imports natural gas from the U.S. and exports natural gas to the U.S.
