An Electronic Technician is responsible the implementation and maintenance of electrical power circuits and equipment, control and automation systems, and electronic equipment used in pipeline systems, compressor stations, as well as interconnect and measurement facilities. Responsibilities will include:

- Installation, inspection, maintenance, calibration, and troubleshooting of electronic equipment such as telemetering, programmable logic controllers (including Allen-Bradley), modems, transducers, sensing devices, radio & satellite equipment, remote terminal units, computer interface equipment and cabling.
- Maintain power distribution systems including motor control centers, UPS, generators, and variable frequency drives.
- Provide coverage for electrical, mechanical, instrumentation and control logic systems for natural gas powered engines and turbines as well as reciprocating and centrifugal gas compressors. Provide inspection for construction and/or maintenance activities performed by third parties for compliance with safety, regulatory requirements, and NEC (National Electrical Code).
- Work with multiple departments to maintain and improve the reliability of company facilities

- Possess an Associate's Degree in Electronics or have equivalent work experience and a valid driver's license.
- Have demonstrated experience and a thorough knowledge of NFPA National Electrical Code, single & three phase systems, digital & analog electronics, electronic test equipment, wiring methods and safety practices.
